#### **Objectives**

The 18<sup>th</sup> Horn of Africa Initiative Ministerial will be held in Addis Ababa and will be chaired by Hon Ahmed Shide, Finance Minister of Ethiopia.

At this meeting, the Ministers and Development Partners (DPs) will continue the discussion on borderlands development and private sector engagement in the Horn of Africa. Building on the discussion at the 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Meetings, as requested by the Finance Ministers, the meeting will hold in-depth discussions on the necessary steps to engage with the international and regional private sector to mobilize private investments and to integrate the private sector partners fully in the policy dialogue both upstream and during implementation of actions under HoAI.

A briefing note on private sector engagement is being circulated and will inform a presentation that will be made by the DPs to frame the discussions. The Ministers will also be presented with a roadmap for the development of the HoA Borderlands based on detailed consultations, will be requested to provide their feedback, and agree on next steps. As requested by Ministers, both roadmaps have been developed based on a deliberative process with stakeholders. The Ministers will be requested to endorse the roadmap that will move to implementation phase after the endorsement.

Continuing with the format implemented at the 16<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Meeting, following remarks by the Chair and the World Bank on behalf of DPs, Ministers and DPs will keep their interventions for the thematic discussions. The meeting will close with the signing of a Financing Agreement for a World Bank grant of US\$730 million for a regional economic corridor linking Djibouti and Ethiopia.
